Weekly Summary

Compared to last week's market, the average prices of all weight classes of feeder steers and heifers ended \$6 to \$10 higher. The slaughter cows weakened by \$2 but most sold today were lower yielding. Slaughter bulls advanced about \$5 on today's comparative figures.

A strong board showing today appears to have produced a more bullish trend as buyers stepped up their game. Heat and drought in the mid-west continues to stifle any wheat planting as the planting season for grazing is getting shorter.
