Compared to last week: all weight classes of feeder steers and heifer price averages ended steady to firm. Slaughter cows showed \$ 4 higher with the slaughter bulls outpacing last week's figures by \$ 6. We continue to see more of the heavier classes being marketed as the bulk of today's feeder calves weighed over 500 lbs. Excellent grazing conditions have allowed the producer to put additional weight on calves that normally would have sold 30 to 45 days ago.

Last Friday's Cattle On Feed Report was considered neutral however the drought monitor continues to show an expanding drought in much of the grazing country.
