Compared to last week's market; all weight class prices averages from 500 lbs and down ended fully \$4 to \$7 weaker with the 500 lbs and up averages fully \$3 to \$5 higher. Slaughter cows today showed to be \$3 better with the slaughter bulls gaining \$4 over last week.

Even with today's strong board closing, the impact of a major winter storm moving through the Midwest's grazing and feedlot regions will send feeder buyers to the sidelines until it passes through. Icy conditions along with possible record snow will inhibit the movement of cattle and stifle feedlot and grazing performance.
