Compared to last weeks market, all weight class price averages of feeder steers and heifers ended fully \$3 to \$6 lower with some lower quality offerings ending \$5 to \$7 lower. The slaughter prices also continue to retreat as the drought continues to have its way forcing the producer to downsize and in some cases liquidate. Slaughter cows and slaughter bulls ended fully \$6 lower.

Even with a bullish cattle on feed report from last Friday, the lack of available grazing lands along with higher input cost is forcing the feeder buyers to become more cautious in their inventory aggression.
