Weekly Summary

Compared to last week's market figures, both the feeder steers and heifers average weight classes finished fully from \$8 to \$12 higher. Slaughter cows finished firm with last week's figures while the slaughter bulls trended \$2 higher.

With live cattle (fats) bringing \$1.61 (the highest we have seen since 2015) the buyer aggression continues to give witness that the predictions of a stronger feeder market this year continues to fall in place. The feeder calf demand on less available inventory nationwide should continue to drive the markets higher as todays ending figures showed this.
