### Weekly Summary

Compared to last week's closing market, all weight class averages of both feeder steers and heifers ended firm with last week's ending figures. The front-end classes however did manage to show \$2 to \$3 higher. Slaughter cows today finished firm with last week while the slaughter bulls weakened by about \$3.

Market analysts feel there could be a possible strong financial undercurrent developing due to two major banks failing. The futures markets are heavily tied in with the financial markets and could well affect cattle futures prices. Inflation fears could also be factored into this. Even with this the bullishness of the market seems unfazed.
