Weekly Summary

Compared to last week's market, the average prices of all classes of feeder steers and heifers ended fully \$6 to \$10 higher. The slaughter cows finished a strong \$7 higher while the slaughter bulls ended firm with last week's figures.

With a peace agreement being signed Friday, oil prices are lowering and the futures are reacting to this good news by posting higher figures. Beef demand will move into the summer periods which have proved historically favorable for beef consumption. The markets also continue to cast a wary eye towards any further developments with the NWS.
