Weekly Summary

Compared to last week's market, the average prices of both feeder steers and heifers caved in to the fear created by last Friday's USDA announcement of the Mexican feeder cattle again being allowed to cross and finished fully \$10 to \$15 lower with some plainer classes being up to \$25 lower. The slaughter cows and bulls again remained mostly firm with last week's figures.

Yesterday's board closing was a disaster, but part of the losses was regained today. Still the feeder buyers showed extreme caution today across on all class purchases. The bullish attitude was dented as the uncertainty of how large an impact the new Mexican feeder cattle could result.

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
