Weekly Summary

Compared to last week's market, the average prices of both feeder steers and heifers ended fully \$10 to \$25 higher with some lighter class instances up to \$30 higher. The slaughter cows and slaughter bulls weakened from \$3 to \$5 lower.

We witnessed a recharge today of both feeder demand and prices. After the fear of the Mexican feeder cattle supposedly crossing in latter August was detailed and analyzed, demand once again took a front row seat as buyers were again I didn't but we can walk down there bullish in their buying.
