Weekly Summary

Compared to last week's market, the average prices of all weight classes of feeder steers and heifers ended from \$7 to \$10 higher. The slaughter cows again weakened by \$3 to \$6 under last week's figures but the slaughter bulls rallied to about \$4 stronger.

Last Friday's USDA On Feed Report was one of the most bullish in recent history which fueled optimism in the feeder buyers' activity today. Buyer aggression and interest was prominent on all classes of feeder calves.
